Breeding Poultry - Mr. Frank

- Must purchase on your own and be an American Poultry Association registered breed
 - Questions on breeds, double check with Mr. Frank
- Ducks cannot be released in the neighborhoods at the conclusion of the show
- No breeding poultry will be sold at the Klein ISD Livestock and Project Show
- Breeding poultry will not be housed at the farm

Photography - Mrs. Philen

- 2024 Theme - Weights and Measures
- Must be the student's original work
- Must be titled

Ag Farm Rules

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Facilities

- Stall/Pen Assignments - The Agriscience teachers will assign all stalls/ pens for student projects. Students may not be change assignments without prior approval by the Agriscience teachers.
- Hours - The project center is open from 5:30 am until 10:00 pm each day. The farm facility is designated for students working with their project(s) and maintaining their areas, so excessive loitering is not allowed.
- Guests - Guests are only permitted at the Ag farm with prior permission from the Agriscience Teacher. Guests are limited to immediate family.

Facilities

- Farm Gates - The individual farm gates must be opened/closed when entering/leaving the facility. Failure to close the gate will result in an alarm notifying the Klein ISD police department. Please be very careful to secure the gate
- Driving - You should drive only on designated areas. Please drive slowly and with extreme caution while on the property and on the road ways leading to the project center. Excessive noise, recklessness, littering, mudding or other disruptive displays will not be tolerated and will result in disciplinary action as outlined in rule (20.)

Facilities

- Cleanliness - The cleanliness of the project center is the direct responsibility of every student who has a project. The teacher will assign specific cleanup duties. Failure to attend farm workdays, without an excused absence, may result in eviction

Safety and Discipline

- The student must comply with all Klein ISD High School Student Handbook policies and home campus rules while working at the Agriscience Project Center. Parents and school administrators shall be notified of student violations while at the Agriscience project center.
- The Agriscience Teachers have the same measure of authority with the student at the project center as in the classroom. The Agriscience Teacher may have additional campus-specific rules, projects, and project center guidance. Such information will be distributed by the Agriscience Teacher to the student.

Safety and Discipline

- Point System – The following point system will be utilized to enforce disciplinary action for students with animals in the project center. This point system will assist in tracking and evaluating student eligibility status during a growing season.
 - Each student begins with 4
 - If your points reach 0 or below, then you will be evicted from the Project Center

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Removal of Projects

- All animals must be removed from the project center within five (5) days following the KISD project show. Projects not removed become property of the FFA chapter and will be sold. Students that become ineligible to show must have the projects removed within five (5) days.

Project Show Rules

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Rule #1 - Pre-Sale Forms

- All exhibitors are encouraged to do a pre-sale form
- Steers, pigs, lambs, goats, poultry, rabbits
- Ensures you have a buyer if you don't make auction
- Can roll over into an add-on, if you make auction
- Due January 16th with check to Mrs. Philen
- IT IS NOT THE AG TEACHERS RESPONSIBILITY TO SELL YOUR ANIMAL!

Rule #2 - Enrolled in Ag Class

- Every student who is showing a project at the Klein ISD Livestock and Project show MUST be enrolled in an agricultural science class at least 1 semester

Rule #3 - Quality Counts

- Every student who is showing a project at the Klein ISD Livestock and Project Show
- MUST be done by December 15th
 - If you have previously completed and not changed levels, you will not have to re-do

Rule #4 - Eligibility

- If a student is ineligible to show because of grades, that animal will not be brought to the KMPC to show or sell
- A student MUST be passing and eligible in order to show at the Klein ISD Livestock and Project Show

Rule #5 - Attend FFA Meetings

- Students may miss no more than 2 FFA meetings per year
- If they miss a 3rd they will lose their ability to take their animal to show and sale
- This WILL be STRICTLY enforced

Rule #6 - Housing

- All projects for Klein ISD must be housed within a 20 mile radius of Klein ISD
- The exhibitor may be required to transport their own animal to weigh days, clipping and shows

Rule #7 - Record Books

- Record for all projects shown for the Klein ISD Livestock and Project Show must be kept in the student's AET record book
- Must keep all finance receipts to input at home on students own time
- Monthly record book workdays to check progress by species advisor

Rule #8/9 - Grooming of Animals

- Exhibitors, ag science teachers, guardians of student/project, current & active fellow FFA chapter members or immediate family members may assist at show facilities for clipping
- No outside fitters will be allowed on show grounds at Klein
- Unethical fitting of livestock and/or treatment of animals is not allowed.
 - Removal will occur if this is found to be true

Rule #10 - Transferring or Animals

- Ownership of projects cannot be transferred after tag in/selection of animals
- Poultry projects can be shared between siblings

Rule #12 - Substance Administration

- Any substance administered to projects at the show barn for illness must be administered under the supervision of a veterinarian
- All expenses are at the cost of the exhibitor

Rule #17 - Animal Identification

- Ear tags and wing bands **MUST** remain in/on the animal or there will be a \$250 fee deducted from the show proceeds by the Show Association

Rule #20 - Show Commission

- Show Commission: Show Commission will be deducted as follows
 - Auction - 10%
 - Freezer Sale - 10%
 - Add-Ons - 10%
 - 1% of the amount above will be designated contingency fund. The remainder will be applied toward show expenses.

Rule #22 - Official Dress

- All exhibitors will be required to wear official dress while showing
 - White shirt, black pants, FFA scarf or tie, black shoes or boots
 - Official FFA Jacket is required for all shows, excluding Floral Design, Horticulture and Ag Science Fair
- All Official Dress including Jacket needs to be ordered by November 1

Rule #23 - Thank You Letters

- Must complete Thank You Letters by March 1st and turn into Mrs. Philen
- 10% reduction in show check each week they are not turned in

Rule #28 - IRS 1099

- Exhibitors receiving more than \$600 in total earnings from the show will be issued an IRS 1099 form

Drug Testing

- The Klein ISD Livestock and Project Show reserves the right to test any project exhibited at the show for illegal substances
 - Grand, Reserve and 1 random from each species will be tested
- Any animal that tests positives will relinquish and funds and awards received
- Hair samples for DNA identification will be taken to establish identity of animals at the time of selection
 - A parent or guardian must be present when the sample is taken (waiver form)

Entry Fees

- Will be paid at the time of animal purchase on September 9th
 - \$25 swine, lamb, goat, steer, heifer
 - \$10 rabbit/breeding rabbit
 - \$10 turkey, broilers, breeding poultry
 - \$10 horticulture, ag mech, photography, agri-science fair
 - \$35 floral design

Freezer Sale

- Options that are available to students in the freezer sale
 - sell the project for the tent sale price
 - send to the processor
- No animals will be allowed to go back to the farm or donated back to the exhibitor

Auction Rules

- Winners of Showmanship will sell in the auction behind the Grand and Reserves (steer, lamb, goat, pig)
- Notification of removal of an animal out of auction by 4:00pm February 9th or will not be allowed to participate again in the Klein ISD Livestock and Project Show
- Only allowed 3 items in the auction
 - Will be the 3 highest places
- Read rules on sale items and slots

Animal Insurance

- If an animal dies within the first 10 days, then the breeder will replace the animal unless the death was due to the exhibitor's negligence.
 - Pigs, lambs and goats ONLY
- Insurance will not be available through Klein ISD Show Association. If you wish to purchase insurance you can do so through an outside vendor.

Barn Card Digital Access Form

Klein ISD has an automated system for entering and exiting the barns off of Klein Cemetery Road. As a result of this each student on farm will receive 2 barn cards for a \$10 fee. These barn cards are the students to keep and may be reused each year they are needed on farm but will be deactivated at the end of this year and reactivated at the start of the following year at the student's request.

For the \$10 fee, you get 2 digital access cards. If both cards are lost and the student will need a replacement card then the cost is \$20.00 per card.
